

2022 MND Prom Guidelines

Friday, May 20th 7:00 p.m. – 11:00 p.m. Cincinnati Music Hall, 1241 Elm Street, Cincinnati, OH 45202

- Tickets are \$60 each, \$120 per couple. They may be purchased online until May 7th.
 - You cannot buy tickets after May 7th!
 - o All girls attending Prom must be currently enrolled at MND.
 - Only ONE GUEST is permitted per MND student. A guest must be at least a freshman in high school and not older than 20 years of age.
- There will be early dismissal from school on the day of Prom.
 - o Any junior who is absent on Friday, May 20th will not be permitted to attend Prom.
- Check in will begin at 6:45 p.m. Dinner starts serving at 7:00 p.m.
- Students must be checked in by 7:45 p.m. Students will receive ONE DEMERIT for every 15 minutes past 7:45.
 - o Parents/guardians will be notified if their daughter is late to Prom.
 - o Call your parents/guardians to inform them if you are running late to Prom so they do not worry if called.
 - Sports conflicts can be accommodated if they are reported to Mr. Fulmer in advance.
 - Arriving early may help with finding a parking spot with other area events happening.
- Students are not permitted to leave Prom before 10:30 p.m.
- Please greet faculty members and chaperones, introducing your date, as you arrive.
- All guests will be expected to present a state-issued photo ID when checking in.
- All students and guests will have their purses/bags/corsage boxes and coat/jackets checked upon entry.
- At MND, the policy (in compliance with state law) prohibits the consumption/use of alcohol and drugs, prior to, during, or after any school related event. This policy also prohibits smoking of any kind during the dance both inside and outside the building.
 - o Parents/guardians will be notified and asked to pick up a student/guest who is/are under the influence of alcohol/drugs or exhibits inappropriate behavior.
 - MND students are responsible for their guests and their actions. If his behavior warrants dismissal from the dance, he becomes the student's liability.
 - Disciplinary action according to the policies listed in the handbook will be enforced.
- The expected dress code is formal attire. Dress should be appropriate in the fact that formalwear is not too tight or revealing by being low cut in the front or back of the dress. (No more than an inch midriff gap) Tuxedos are preferred, but suit and ties are acceptable. Admittance to Prom may be refused if your attire is deemed unsuitable. Guests must keep their shirt on and buttoned at the dance.
- Vulgar dancing—grinding or any dancing that simulates sexual activity is strictly prohibited. Students engaging in
 inappropriate dancing will be asked to leave the dance floor. This behavior may result in dismissal from the dance
 after contact with the parents/guardians. Disciplinary action may follow.
- Before and after dance activities are not sanctioned by MND. There is no MND-organized After-Prom.

Please be safe and smart in all your decisions, both before and after the dance.
