- **Tablet PC Repair:** All Tablet PC repairs are handled through MND's Technology Center. No other repair center is authorized to work on an MND Tablet PC and doing so will nullify the provided warranty. A loaner Tablet PC will be assigned, if deemed necessary. Repairs fall into three categories:
 1. **REPAIR TYPE I** - Any hardware failure during the normal course of use will be covered under the four-year warranty.
 2. **REPAIR TYPE II** - If the Tablet PC is accidentally damaged, the Tablet PC will be covered by the included Accidental Damage Protection (ADP) Warranty. The ADP warranty covers only accidental damage. It does not cover loss, theft, intentional damage and damage incurred by improper care. Additionally, it does not cover the replacement of consumables such as the stylus or batteries. Only one accidental incident will be covered per student per school year.
 3. **REPAIR TYPE III:** If the Tablet PC or any consumables are lost or stolen, the family must replace the missing component(s) and/or the Tablet PC.
