

LIZ MARKSTEINER '04 ENDOWED MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The Liz Marksteiner '04 Endowed Memorial Scholarship has been established by the family and friends of Liz Marksteiner and the Class of 2004. Liz Marksteiner died in January of 2002 during her sophomore year at Mount Notre Dame, after a 16-month battle with cancer. Liz was always questing for knowledge in and out of school. She never missed an opportunity to ask and learn about almost everything. Liz came from a local public school to Mount Notre Dame to give Catholic schools a chance. The scholarship is non-renewable and must be used during the junior year at Mount Notre Dame. A \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded.
